**WHERE:** San Juan Ranch Shop (see map)

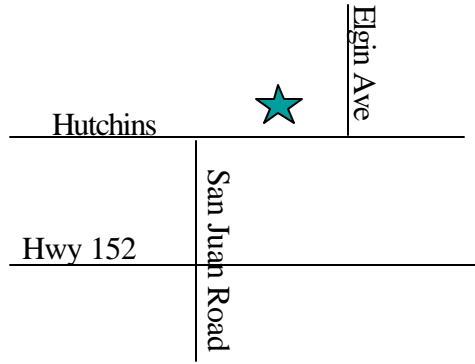
