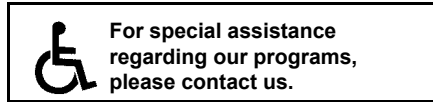


**Directions:**

From west bound Avenue 7 ½ (13<sup>th</sup> in Firebaugh), turn left (S) on O Street, continue to 1360 O Street (hall is set back on right, across from courthouse park).

From north bound 33 to Firebaugh turn right at first light (13<sup>th</sup>), continue to 4-way stop and turn right (O Street) continue to 1360 O Street (across from courthouse park).

From south bound 33 to Firebaugh, turn left at second light (13<sup>th</sup>), continue to 4-way stop and turn right (O Street) continue to 1360 O Street (across from courthouse park).
