DATE: *Wednesday, May 15, 2002 (third Wednesday of the month)*

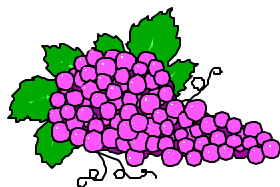
TIME: *12:00 noon*
