TIME: *12:00 noon*

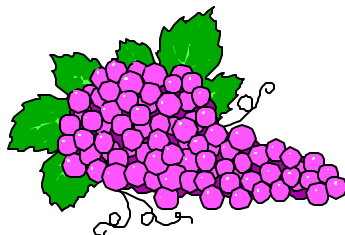
